Description of Lesson (Including Instructional Strategies):
Art: Students will create a mosaic using a picture of a heart.
Music: Students will pick a song/rap of their choice with no profanity and will examine the lyrics. Students will explain in their own words what the chorus and one verse mean to them. In addition, students will look for figurative languages in the song.
Guided Practice: Teacher will assist students in deciphering the song chosen. Students will work in pairs/groups creating the mosaic.
