### Reading Fluency Tip:

Use What the Child Already Knows about Word Parts
Let's face it... written English can be very confusing
with all its rules and irregularities. Useful strategies
for teaching reading include a plethora of constructs
including phonemic awareness, phonics,
comprehension, fluency, and vocabulary to name a
few. This tip makes use of phonics. Here are a few
prompts to use when the phonics in a word might be
helpful for a child to notice.

- 1. Do you see any parts in the word that you know? For example, if the child knows the word CAT and he/she is looking at the word FLAT, the "at" part is familiar.
- 2. If the first prompt doesn't result in success, an alternative question could be, "Does this look like any other word you know?
- 3. If these first two prompts don't result in a correct response, you can say, "Knowing the word CAT can help you with this word because of the AT part.' Show him/her the part that is the same.
