Level 2: I can tell initial, medial, or final sounds of each word.
(*Students must tell at least 2 out of 3 sounds of each word.)

Direction: “Tell me the initial, medial, or final sounds you hear in each word.”

Level 3: I can tell the beginning, middle, and ending sounds of each word.

Direction: “Tell me the initial, medial, and final sounds you hear in each word.”

Level 4: I can create a list of 3-5 CVC words.

Direction: “Write 3-5 CVC words independently.”
